§ **Beta version of VIAF released** §

OCLC has hosted and implemented a beta version of the [Virtual International Authority File](#). Over a dozen—mainly national—libraries are participating by making available their authority files. While each libraries files can be accessed individually, a meta-search of all simultaneously is available through a single search box at the site. This resource may be particularly useful in cases where the unique identity of a person is elusive but may be illuminated in other authority records.

§ **The economics of MARC at the Library of Congress** §

The consulting firm R2 Consulting LLC, retained by the Library of Congress “to investigate and describe current approaches to the creation and distribution of MARC records in U.S. and Canadian libraries,” issued its report in October 2009.
