**Sorting out Genre Headings and *LCSH* Topical Headings:
LC formally separates them**

In a statement dated June 17, 2010, the Library of Congress outlined a plan to formally separate topical *LCSH* headings from headings used as genres. In recent years, interest in and use of genre headings has grown, as has some confusion regarding coding and applying them, not to mention how their use would play out in local online catalogs. The Library of Congress is developing genre headings on a discipline by discipline basis, with headings for cartographic resources being the latest to be added. Read the [July 9, 2010 statement on cartographic genre/form headings](#).
