### Revised Personal Name Heading Access Points for Noteworthy Catholics by Tom Duszak

The United States Postal Service issued its 44 cent postage stamp commemorating the life of **Mother Teresa** on September 5, 2010. Sixty million postage stamps were printed and distributed for sale. Please use them in your personal and institutional mailings.
