Former First Lady **Nancy Reagan** died on March 6, 2016 at age 94. As wife of the 40th president of the United States, she helped to raise awareness and stimulate research on Alzheimer's Disease. The correct access point for works by and about Mrs. Reagan is:

Reagan, Nancy, #d 1921-2016

Monsignor **Thomas Hartman**, born May 22, 1946 in Richmond Hill, Queens, New York, died Tuesday, February 16, 2016 in Uniondale, New York at age 69. He was well-known as the straight man of the Catholic-Jewish duo with Rabbi Marc Gellman that exchanged religious conversation in the partnership known as The God Squad on television and radio and in newspaper columns. The correct access point for works by and about Monsignor Hartman is:

Monsignor **Kevin W. Irwin** is one of the Catholic Church's experts on Vatican II and the Papacy. He is the Monsignor Walter J. Schmitz Professor of Liturgical Studies at the Catholic University of America. Among his titles are *Serving the Body of Christ: The Magisterium on Eucharist and Ordained Priesthood* (2013) and *The Sacraments: Historical Foundation and Liturgical Theology* (2016). The correct access point for works by and about Monsignor Irwin is:

He wrote 25 books, including *Caesar's Coin: Religion and Politics in America* (1987). The correct access point for works by and about Father McBrien is:

Mother Angelica, founder of the Eternal Word Television Network, died Easter Sunday, March 27, 2016. Check your catalog. The correct access point for titles by and about Mother Angelica is:
