Tentatively, this is to be an online-only, subscription product, with rates varying depending on the number of simultaneous users. [The following clarification appears as a note at the end of Weekly List 50—editor]:

War on Terrorism, 2001-2009

The heading for the War on Terrorism was revised to close the date span because the phrase was coined by the Bush Administration and is no longer in use by the government. The scope note now reads:

Here are entered works on the events, metaphorically referred to as a “war,” consisting of military operations, diplomatic activities, and other counterterrorist measures undertaken by the United States during the period from September 11, 2001 to the end of the administration of George W. Bush. Works on government antiterrorist measures and activities during earlier or later periods are entered under Terrorism--Prevention.

Catalogers are reminded that the free-floating subdivisions valid for use under wars cannot be applied to the heading War on Terrorism, 2001-2009 (see the first paragraph of SHM H 1200).
