On the Horizon: the DeMARCation of the Cataloging Record

In an October 31, 2011 news release entitled "A Bibliographic Framework for the Digital Age," the Working Group of the Future of Bibliographic Control has made recommendations to the Library of Congress. Recommendation 3.1.1 states:

“Recognizing that Z39.2/MARC are no longer fit for the purpose, work with the library and other interested communities to specify and implement a carrier for bibliographic information that is capable of representing the full range of data of interest to libraries, and of facilitating the exchange of such data both within the library community and with related communities.”

Cardinal John P. Foley, 1935-2011*

Cardinal John Patrick Foley died Sunday, December 11, 2011 in Darby, Pennsylvania at age 76. The cause was leukemia. Cardinal Foley's voice was known to millions throughout the world as the English language narrator on broadcasts of the Holy Father's midnight Christmas Mass in St. Peter's Basilica. Foley, an only child, started writing radio plays about the lives of the saints in the seventh grade. He was ordained in 1962. He received a master's degree from Columbia University School of Journalism in 1966. His dissertation was entitled "Natural Law, Natural Right and the Warren Court." The Library of Congress created and released a name authority for Cardinal Foley on December 12, the next day after his death. See NAR n 2011-85293. This numbering means that the Foley authority record is the 85,293rd created by the Library of Congress in calendar year 2011. For works by and about Cardinal Foley, the authorized access point in bibliographic records is:
