Personal Name Access Points: New and Revised

Pope Benedict XVI canonized seven saints on Sunday, October 21, 2012. Among them were Saint Kateri, the Lily of the Mohawks, who lived in the 17th century. Lily of the Mohawks is one of the cross references in her name authority record (NAR). Visit the Library of Congress Authorities website at <http://authorities.loc.gov/> to find her and other personal, corporate, and geographic access points. The access points for four of the seven new saints and several recently revised access points are listed below:

The above is not valid for use as a subject on bibliographic records. Works about Pope Benedict XVI are entered under his personal access point:

The Vatican verified on March 13, 2013 that the new pope will be known as Pope Francis, not Pope Francis I. The bulletin issued by the Vatican announcing Cardinal Jorge Mario Bergoglio as pope called him simply Francis. He will become Francis I after there is a pope named Francis II. His new access points are:

Patriarch Maxim of Bulgaria, who survived the revolt over his Communist-era ties to lead Bulgaria's Orthodox Christians for more than 40 years, died in Sofia, Bulgaria on November 6, 2012. Patriarch Maxim hosted Pope John Paul II during his visit to Sofia in 2002. The revised access point for Patriarch Maxim is:

Absalom, the third son of David, has a revised access point:
100 0_ Absalom, \$c (Biblical figure)
