DESCRIPTIVE CATALOGING NEWS

Thesaurus of Occupational Terms in Religion

A Taskforce on Best Practices in the Field of Religion has been formed under the auspices of ATLA, CLA, and ACL, with Judy Knop, currently the Coordinator of the NACO Funnel Project for ATLA, serving as Chair. She writes:

“At the ATLA Annual Conference in June, members of the NACO discussion group called for the development of a Thesaurus of Occupational Terms in Religion for use in the 374 field of the personal name authority records. The suggestion was that this be developed as a recognized standard, thus allowing us to use a standard abbreviation for it in the \$2 of the 374.”

The aim of the Taskforce is to develop a uniform thesaurus of occupational terms in the field of religion which would be drawn upon in entering data in the new RDA authority record field 374. Just a sprinkling of examples of such terms among the dozens currently under consideration are: Clergy; Rabbis; Monks; Nuns; Missionaries; Christian librarians; Ministers of music.

Professor Mary T. Clark

Mary T. Clark, R.S.C.J. died on Labor Day, September 1, 2014 in Albany, New York. Born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania on October 23, 1913, she was a member of the faculty at Manhattanville College and served as visiting professor at St. John Neumann Seminary for more than 20 years.
