Personal Name Access Points

Cardinal Francis Eugene George, born January 16, 1937, died Friday April 17, 2015 at age 78. He was the Roman Catholic archbishop of Chicago for 17 years and helped shape the American Catholic bishops response to the child sexual abuse scandal and their resistance to the Obama health plan's contraception coverage. Robert McQueen Grant, born November 25, 1917 in Evanston, Illinois, died June 10, 2014 in Hyde Park, Chicago at age 96. He was an ordained minister in the Protestant Episcopal Church and served as Carl Darling Buck Professor Emeritus of New Testament and Early Christian Literature at the University of Chicago Divinity School where he taught from 1953 until his retirement in 1988. He was the most influential American historian of ancient Christianity of his generation and an international authority on U-boats in World War I.
